Curriculum Proposal - October 17, 2014

The Interior Architecture Program completed a major curriculum change in Spring of 2014, in response to a self study prepared for CIDA's accreditation visit in the previous semester. That change is currently in effect. In the late Spring, the IA faculty reviewed one section of the curriculum changes: Required Related courses. This section was expanded originally to allow IA majors to participate in more business and professional courses related to the profession of Interior Architecture. Student feedback prompted a closer examination of how these required related courses relate to certificate programs offered within the University. Additionally, it offers other design related courses beyond those contained in the spring changes. Additionally, there is one course which was omitted in the spring changes that needs to be replaced: SOC 1000.
